

BB: He is a prophet.

P-2: Lets get his parents here and find out if he was really blind.

(Parents interscene)

Father: We have been ordered to the temple to explain our son's ability to see.

Mother: Oh my God! We didn't do anything.

F: Steady. Lets just tell them what happened.

M: No! No! No! They have threatened to expel and shun anyone who believes in Jesus. If we say Jesus healed him, they will accuse us of belief.

F: OK. OK. Here's what we have to do. We'll have to admit he is our son; we'll have to admit he's been blind but can now see. Everybody saw us standing there watching when Jesus touched his eyes. All we can say is, "We don't know what happened".

P-2: Is this really your son who was born blind?
If so, how is it that he is now able to see?

Parents: (Unison) We recognize our own son and we know he was born blind, but we don't know how it is that he can see now, or who opened his eyes. He is old enough; ask him.

P-1:(To BB) Give glory and credit to God.
We have investigated; Jesus is an ordinary person, nothing special.
We also know he is a Sabbath violator, a sinner.

BB: I don't know if he is a sinner.
I only know that I was blind and now I can see.

P-2: What did he do to you?
How did he open your eyes?

BB: I told you once and you wouldn't listen!
Why do you want to hear it all again?
Do you want to become a disciple of Jesus also?

P-1,2,3: You worthless beggar!
You ignorant sinner!
You can be his disciple but we are disciples of Moses.
We know that God spoke to Moses, but as for this man Jesus,
we don't know where he comes from.

BB: Now here is an astonishing thing.
He has opened my eyes and you don't know where he comes from.
You have always taught us: God doesn't listen to sinners,
but God does listen to men who are devout and who do his will.
Ever since the world began it is unheard of for anyone to open
the eyes of a man who was born blind.
If this man were not from God, he couldn't do a thing.

P-1: Are you, an ignorant sinner, trying to teach us what we teach?
Get out! Get out, and don't come back!
